Learning to read can change the trajectory of the path of a student's life. Opening the door to possibilities and options for careers, politics, social connections, and more. This is the belief of Clear Vista's Inclusion Coach, Julie Reed, and Early Literacy Teacher, Amanda Graff.

Julie Reed, Inclusion Coach has been at Clear Vista for the past year. Her role is to support success for all students. Part of her job includes supporting teachers with Individual Program Plans, Behavior Support Plans, and Success in School Plans. Julie works with our many different families to support in a variety or ways. Helping to coordinate assessments with WRPS Multidisciplinary Team along with coordinating programming and educational supports in the classroom is integral to her role. Clear Vista has many wonderful Educational Assistants who support many students and small group interventions. The coordination of this all falls under the Inclusion Coach's umbrella.

Amanda Graff, Clear Vista's new Early Literacy Teacher, brings experience and connection with many of our students from both her prior schools Norwood and Parkdale, along with working in Chinook's Edge. Amanda will be working with small groups to help build stronger foundations in literacy for students who have gaps in their learning. Her interventions will align with research-based strategies and instruction within the classroom, ensuring that students have access to the strategies that they need support and instruction in.

Clear Vista will have a multi-faceted approach for literacy and numeracy interventions this year. Julie and Amanda are planning interventions as a team with a whole school approach. Our amazing EA's will work with small groups (3-5 students) from their assigned class using a variety of literacy and numeracy supports as guided by the Literacy Support Teacher and Inclusion Coach.

"Our goal is to build strong readers. To do this, we need to target the specific areas that each student needs support in, so we can help build their reading skills. We believe that with explicit and systematic instruction in phonics, phonemic awareness, vocabulary, morphology and other strands of reading, we can strengthen the reading abilities of our students who are close to grade level as well as those who are falling behind. We want to see ALL students see themselves as readers which in turn brings a love for learning across the board as they can comprehend what they are reading. **To read is to know.**"
